



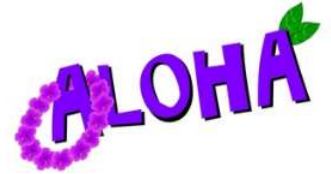

IMPORTANT COVID-19 UPDATE:

We are also allowing participants to sit two at a table, hopefully enhancing socialization.
FACE MASKS ARE STILL REQUIRED.

Please keep in mind that the following safety protocols will remain in place:

- Masks must be worn at all times.

- If a kupuna participant feels sick while at the center, their family/caregiver will be notified and will be asked to pick them up early.
- If a participant is traveling off-island, please quarantine for five days before returning to the center and take a COVID-19 test on the fifth day, and is negative, the participant may return to KSP.



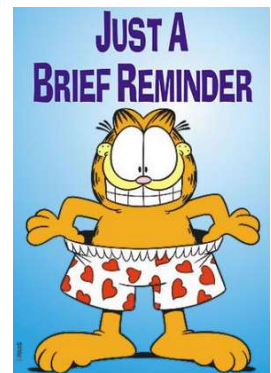
KUPUNA SUPPORT MOVING TO ROOM 302
