Aloha KSP participants and families!
All programs at MCC (Kupuna Support, Senior Center, Children and Families, and Japanese Language School) continue to maintain our COVID-19 protocols to ensure the safety of our participants and staff. KSP will continue to require clients and staff to wear masks, social distance, check temperatures, and disinfect areas/surfaces. If participants are traveling off island, they must quarantine for 4-5 days before returning to the program. Please ensure that your loved one is wearing a mask when they come to the center.

As you may know, the minimum wage has been raised to \$12 starting 10/1/22. To maintain our quality care for your loved ones, **the cost of our program has increased to \$75.** Please contact Chelsie for any questions or concerns.

Just a friendly reminder, if your loved one is not going to attend KSP on their scheduled day, please inform Chelsie or Jon before 8:00 am on that day. This is to ensure we order the correct number of lunches and prepare the correct number of activities. Please note that if you do not notify staff before 8:00am, you will still be charged the standard rate for that day.
