All programs at MCC continue to maintain our COVID-19 protocols to ensure the safety of our participants and staff. KSP will continue to require clients and staff to wear masks, social distance, check temperatures, and disinfect areas/surfaces. If participants are traveling off island, they must quarantine for 4-5 days before returning to the program. **Please ensure that your loved one is wearing a mask when they come to the center.**
