The Children and Families Program's Summer Intersession is from May 30 to July 28. Please be aware that the children will be on property during this time. All programs at MCC continue to maintain our COVID-19 protocols to ensure the safety of our participants and staff. KSP will continue to require clients and staff to wear masks, social distance, check temperatures, and disinfect areas/surfaces. If participants are traveling off island, they must quarantine for 4-5 days before returning to the program. **Please ensure that your loved one is wearing a mask when they come to the center.**

Just a friendly reminder, if your loved one is not going to attend KSP on their scheduled day, **please inform Chelsie or Jon before 8:00 am on that day.** This is to ensure we order the correct number of lunches and prepare the correct number of activities. **Please note that if you do not notify staff before 8:00am, you will still be charged the standard rate for that day.**
