Aloha KSP clients and families!

All programs at MCC (Kupuna Support, Senior Center, Children and Families, and Japanese Language School) continue to maintain our COVID-19 protocols to ensure the safety of our participants and staff. KSP will continue to require clients and staff to wear masks, social distance, check temperatures, and disinfect areas/surfaces. Please ensure that your loved one is wearing a mask when they come to the center.

As you may know, the minimum wage has been raised to \$12 starting 10/1/22. To maintain our quality care for your loved ones, **we will be increasing the cost of our program to \$75 per day starting in January 2023.** Please contact Chelsie for any questions or concerns.
